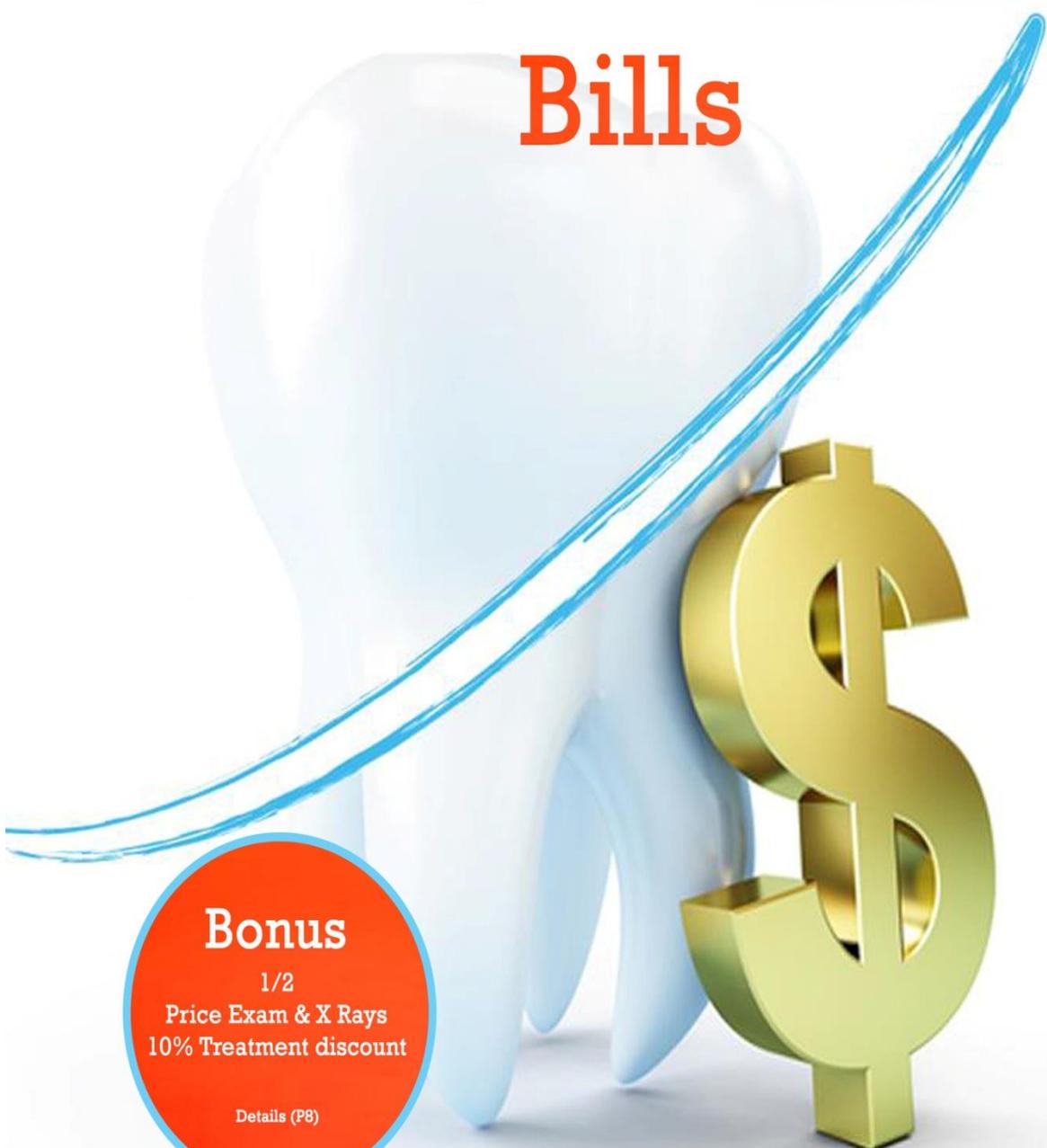

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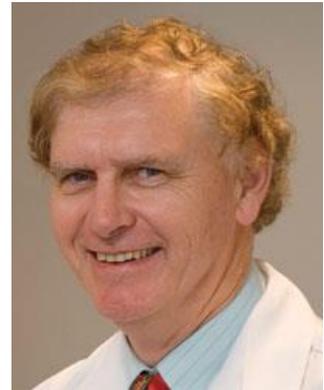

Why do we need good dental care?

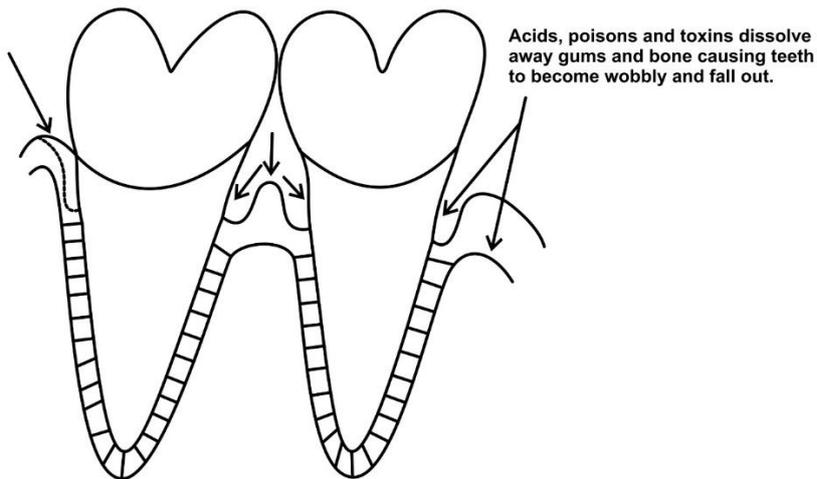
Basically, the mouth is a difficult area to keep healthy. It is moist, warm with many forms of bacteria present. This makes it a challenging environment for restorative materials to live in. This means that things can easily get out of balance, causing tooth decay and gum disease.

Poor home care involves leaving food behind around your teeth and gums attracting bacteria. This is called plaque, which if left long enough calcifies into calculus. These products release poisons, acids, toxins etc. which can cause tooth decay as well as gum disease.

In recent years, scientists have also found that poor oral conditions can allow inflammatory products to leave the mouth area and head to all the major body organs causing problems WHICH CAN BE POTENTIALLY FATAL. These include increased risks of heart attack, cancer, stroke, premature birth, diabetes and Alzheimer's disease.

Obviously, none of these are desirable.

PERIODONTITIS INFLAMMATION OF THE GUMS

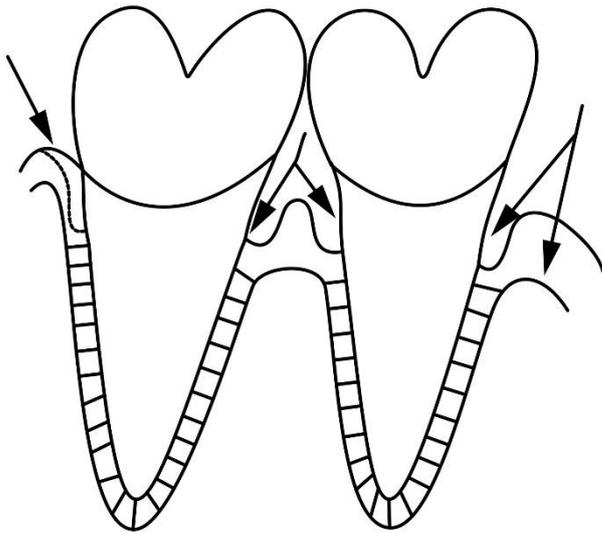


How does gum disease work?

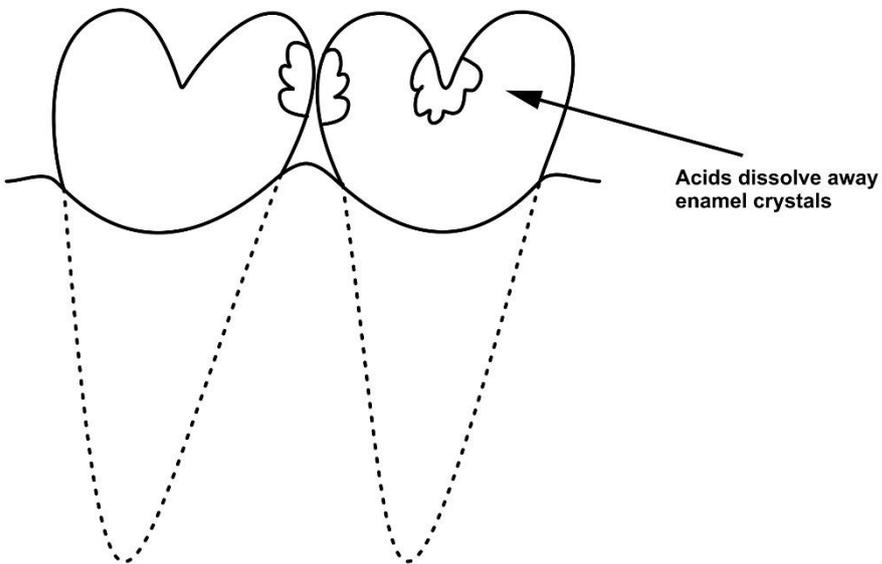
